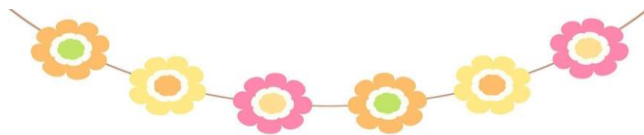

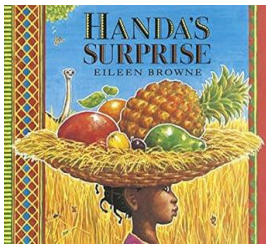
In Religious Education we have been learning about places of worship. We worked together to make mosques and churches using different materials.
