On Line Safety Tip



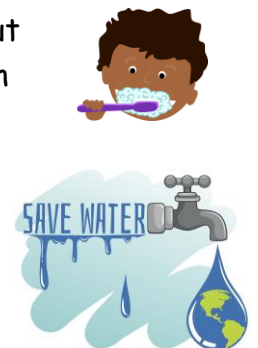

Owls

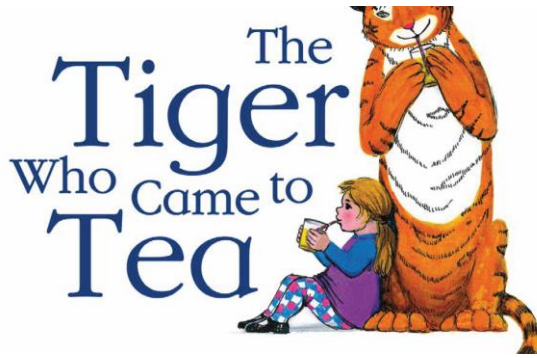
We were very lucky to have some owls visit Tottenham this week. We watched them fly, listened to information and had a photograph taken with the barn owl.

Year 1 have been drawing pictures of owls using metallic pens.



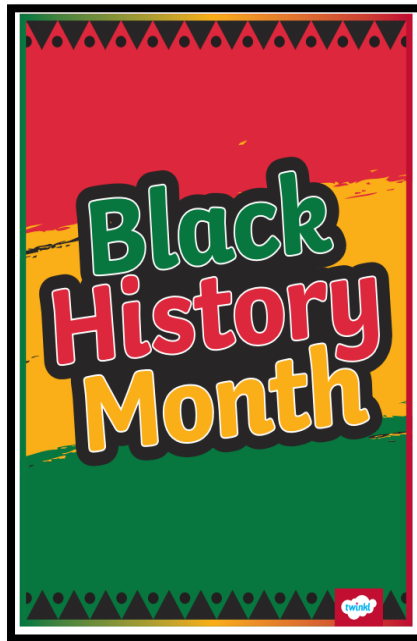
The photographs of the children with the owl will be made available soon. We will let you know when they are ready for you to purchase.
