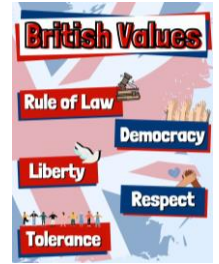

Thank you to all those who attended the Nativity Performances last week. We were so proud of all the children who showed courage and confidence.





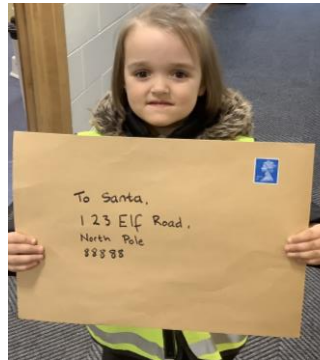
St Cuthbert's Church
